60% of impacted businesses are left severely impaired.

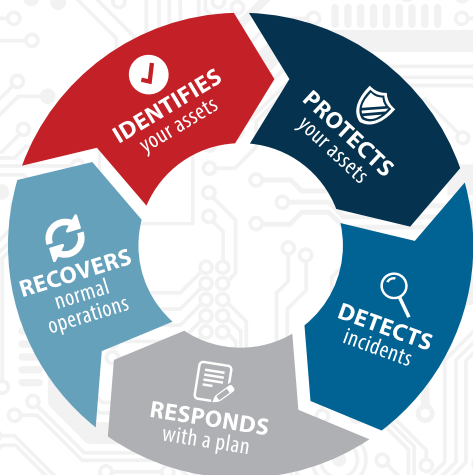
\$38K is the average cost for a small business to overcome a data breach.
