Anthony Edmondson will give a brief overview of Best Practices for Departmental Administrators working with corporate bureaucracy. This presentation will help both UAH students entering the workforce and seasoned professionals navigate the necessary bureaucracies we all face in the world of research. This year, he presented and co-presented at conferences on this subject at The Society of Research Administrators

International's Annual Meeting held in San Francisco, CA (SRAI - Oct. 2019) and The National Council of University Research Administrators – Region III Spring Meeting in Hollywood, FL (NCURA - May of 2019).

Anthony Edmondson is the Research Program Administrator at The University of Alabama in Huntsville's Propulsion Research Center. He manages the research center's financial operations and serves as liaison to administrative and academic departments on the university's campus. He has 19 years of experience at institutions of higher learning and additional years in the private sector as an accountant. Mr. Edmondson was a 2016 recipient of both the UAH Staff Excellence Award and NCURA's Catherine Core Minority Travel Award. He received a B.S. in Accounting from Northeastern Illinois University and an M.B.A. from The University of Alabama in Huntsville. Prior to his career in Accounting and Research Administration, Mr. Edmondson worked for the Secretary of the United States Air Force where he escorted civic leader tours to U.S. Air Force installations in Colorado Springs, CO and coordinated logistics for the Chicago Air and Water Show. His efforts earned him The Air Force Exemplary Civilian Service Award.
