

Army Training and Certification Tracking System (ATCTS) is Sunsetting

BLUF:

The Army is officially announcing the decommissioning of ATCTS effective 1 May 2025. The ATCTS system has two major functions: (1) Network Access Management and (2) DoD Cyber Workforce Qualifications Management. This decision was made after thorough evaluation and consideration of alternative systems that will better meet the current operational needs of our Army.

Access to Historical Information

While ATCTS capabilities will sunset 1 MAY 25, ATCTS will remain in a read-only access until 01 OCT 2025 for historical records review (will not accept new data). Personnel needing access to past training records can access the records on https://atcts.army.mil.

Instructions for DoD Cyber Workforce Qualifications Management

This decision will impact all personnel with network access and positions required to perform cyberspace work, including DA civilians, Military (COMPOs 1-3), and Cyber Workforce personnel occupying any of the 73 DoD Cyberspace Workforce Framework roles. This includes civilian and military personnel performing cyberspace work roles to meet qualification standards established in DoD and augmented where appropriate by contracted services support personnel.

What does this mean:

The sunsetting of ATCTS requires managers and users (Soldiers, Civilians and contractors) to take actions listed below, NLT 30 April to prepare for the sunsetting and save training certifications and certificates.
