Our luncheon speaker will be Dr. L.R. (Ron) Greenwood, former Vice President for Research. Dr. Greenwood, a Certified Financial Planner, will speak on money management during retirement.

Don't forget: You MUST have your PEEHIP card and a reservation to take advantage of the free health screening.

#### Message from the President (F. Lee Cook)

Welcome to our new year. We sincerely hope that you will come and join us at our first 2010-2011 meeting on Wednesday, October 13, at 11:30 a.m. in University Center room 126.

Details of the meeting are in the first article but I would like to emphasize the FREE HEALTH **SCREENING** that we have set up through our PEEHIP plan. The screening will include this year's flu shot, a complete lipid profile, a check of your body mass index, a bone density screening, blood pressure and pulse readings, and a follow-up counseling session. The whole process takes 15-20 minutes per individual; and, depending on the RSVPs we get for screening (see your announcement card), we can set up multiple stations so that several retirees can be screened at once.

For your convenience, we have set up the screening process in UC127 both before (10:00-11:30 a.m.) and after, (1:00-2:00 p.m.),

the meeting. <u>**BRING</u>** your new PEEHIP card with you to the screening room. I hope that many of you take advantage of this free and valuable service. I know that I will!</u>

Another matter that should be of interest to you is a summary of the 2010 District 2 Annual Meeting of AERA (Alabama Education Retirees Association). The meeting was held at Snead State College on August 18, with 104 District 2 retirees attending. A free health screening was provided.

I noted at least five major points that need to be passed on:

- 1. The fiscal year 2011 (Oct. 1, 2010-Sept. 30, 2011) will be bleak for education retirees. The most important thing that we can do is research the candidates and vote this November only for those who say they support and have a record of supporting education. REMEMBER: the new legislature will be redistricting the State and that redistricting will last for ten years. Guess how incumbents tend to "shape" their districts!
- 2. Alabama now has the second largest retiree association (AERA) in the country. Only Michigan, with its vastly larger population, exceeds our size. Our size and strength are due largely to the tremendous organization

of retirees across the State (81 local units) which is coordinated and led by our extremely capable AERA staff and Janice Charlesworth, its Executive Secretary, in Montgomery. Without their constant and persuasive lobbying, using many of the local unit members, our plight in the coming year would be considerably worse.

- 3. This past year AERA ran a Statewide Community Service project called "Yes, We CAN Feed Alabama". The campaign collected 17.853 cans of food, \$4,000, and another 700 pounds of noncanned food. The program was such a success that the AERA Community Service Committee unanimously agreed to continue this project for 2010-2011 with a goal of doubling the number of cans collected. I sincerely hope that UAHRA can make a significant contribution to this worthy state-wide project this year. We get to specify to which organization(s) our food or cash contributions go. AERA only asks that we report our totals.
- 4. With regard to the changes in our PEEHIP drug program, the following points are pertinent:
  - a. The PEEHIP Board is made up of 14 individuals: 8 elected by

AEA/AERA and six others by virtue of their various state offices. Dr. Paul Hubbard is the Chair and Ms. Sarah Swindle of AERA is the Vice-Chair.

- b. Because of level funding for the coming year, the decision was made to save as many teacher positions as possible and decrease the funding for PEEHIP.
- c. Faced with the \$500-\$600 million deficit in education, \$255 million was made up in PEEHIP for the coming year. An extensive survey led to the principle that retirees were willing to pay a little more rather than have their benefits cut. The change in drug companies (Ex-Scripts press to *MedImpact*) was made because of MedImpact's lower bid and a savings of roughly \$45 million. In addition, \$60 million was borrowed from the Edu-Trust Fund. cation The first new deductions will show up on our end-of-September checks.
- d. For those families of two with family cov-

erage and with two allocations from the State (both of you in TRSA), that benefit has been removed. It may now be cheaper to change to two single coverages.

e. You will receive a new insurance card in September, but use it <u>ONLY</u> after 30 September and have your pharmacist and doctors make a copy. Use your old card through the month of September.

5. For those of you interested in which drugs with *MedImpact* are "Maintenance considered Drugs" and which are "Formulary considered (Preferred) Drugs", I will distribute copies of both lists at the meeting.
